Cutting Clause

In the event of a pipe and/or structural steel section being damaged but being reasonably usable for the purpose for which it was originally intended if the damaged part is cut off, Underwriters' liability shall be for the proportion of the insured value which the length of the part cut off bears to the length of the complete pipe and/or structural steel section but they shall have the benefit of any salvage in respect thereof. In addition the Underwriters shall be liable for the costs of cutting, cutting and refitting flanges, recutting bevels or otherwise rendering the pipe usable for its original purpose.

In case of conflict between this clause and body of the policy or other additional clauses , this clause shall prevail. All other terms, conditions, and exclusions of the policy shall remain unchanged.
