

Packing clause

Clause 4.3 of the Institute Cargo Clauses is amended to read: “loss damage or expense caused by insufficiency of packing or preparation of the interest insured when this is done with the insured’s control, privity or knowledge. For the purpose of this clause, packing shall also be deemed to include stowage in a container or liftvan. When a claim is paid under this clause, the insurer is entitled to exercise its right of subrogation.

In case of conflict between this clause and body of the policy or other additional clauses , this clause shall prevail. All other terms, conditions, and exclusions of the policy shall remain unchanged.
